
Bandag is Bridgestone's business unit dedicated to the research, development, and manufacturing of premium retread tires. An industry best practice for large commercial fleets, retreading is the process of replacing the tread of a tire casing with a new tread rather than replacing the entire tire. The retreading process helps defer millions of tires from landfills annually by keeping them on the road instead of removing them from service after one use. Through the reduced natural resource consumption that results from the retreading process, approximately 225 million gallons of oil are saved annually given that one retread saves 15 gallons of oil and approximately 15 million tires are retreaded each year. Not only is retreading a sustainable business practice, but it can also help fleets lower tire costs to as low as 1.5 cents per mile.
