

# Heritage Park move forward

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## SPALDING COUNTY

- The proposed Spalding County building set to be constructed at The Lakes in Green Valley is currently in full permit status.

TJ Imberger, county parks, public grounds and public works director, gave an update of the remaining special local option sales tax projects at the Jan. 13 Spalding County Parks and Leisure Services Advisory Commission meeting.

Plans for the aquatic center call for an eight-lane competition pool and a smaller pool to be used for

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therapy and construction.

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During his update, Imberger said land disturbance permits have been submitted and permits with the Spalding County

Health Department are in the works. Construction documents are completed, and once the permitting process is complete, the project will be sent to county commissioners for bid.

As for the Heritage Park project, Imberger said trusses for the Rosenwald Building should be coming in next week and will be installed immediately after

they arrive.

The Heritage Park project includes renovations to the existing Fairmont Gym, the Equalization Building and the Rosenwald School building. The project also calls for walking trails, a playground and a pavilion in Heritage Park.

When the 2016 SPLOST was proposed, the Heritage Park project was one of several bonded projects slated to be completed up front.

Renovations to the Fairmont Gym are in the design phase and should be ready for bidding within the next 30 to 90 days, Imberger said.
