HK LOGISTICS TO BUILD AND OPERATE NEW FACILITY IN GRIFFIN, GEORGIA

MILWAUKEE, WISCONSIN, AUGUST 23, 2011 --- HK Logistics, a leading provider of critical logistics services including receiving and supplier validation, warehousing, kitting, subassembly, sequencing of material and third-party inventory, today announces they will build and operate a new distribution center on 11 acres of property in the Green Valley Industrial Park located in Griffin, Georgia. The project capital investment is projected to be \$30,000,000 with the creation of approximately 70 jobs.

Tom Stricker, President of HK Logistics, stated "HK Logistics looks forward to a long term partnership with the City of Griffin and Spalding County. We are excited about the future business relationships we will develop and look forward to working with the residents and businesses in the area. As we construct our facility over the next year and hire the staff to operate it we will draw on the local suppliers and workforce to help us succeed."

The Griffin Logistics Center will be located at 375 Green Valley Road, where HK Logistics will provide on-site storage and value added services. The facility will house office space as well as various types of high density storage systems allowing for greater product storage while consuming less space. In addition, the facility will utilize conveyors and Warehouse Management Software to provide for efficient and reliable material movement and storage. The combination of high density storage, conveyance and software will provide substantial operational benefits including space utilization, asset utilization and cost savings.

"We certainly welcome HK Logistics to Green Valley Industrial Park and our community. Their commitment to construct a new \$30,000,000 logistics facility and create an estimated 70 new jobs in our community will be a great boost to our tax base and overall economy. Though the economic recovery still appears weak at best, we are encouraged by the commitments we are beginning to see from the business community to prepare for the demands of a more robust economic recovery" stated Griffin-Spalding Development Authority Chair, Chuck Copeland.
